Answer **both** questions.

1 Study and perform **one** of the prescribed Set Dances as notated:

- (a) *Wolubena*, Stephenson (1996) African dance;
- (b) *Pasos Terrenales*, Smith (1990) ballet;
- (c) *Memories of When*, Smith (1986) modern dance;
- (d) *Nobene*, Sarker (1991) South Asian dance.

The scores, in Benesh Notation and Labanotation, are to be found in a separate book which accompanies this examination paper. (40 marks)

2 Study, memorise and perform a dance study from a notated score in **one** of the following genres: African dance, ballet, modern dance or South Asian dance. The score will be handed to you on the day of the examination and you will be given thirty minutes to prepare it. The performance must be without the score in hand. (20 marks)
