**A poster drawn by Emily Ford in 1908.**

**Ford was an artist who also designed pamphlets, banners and postcards supporting women's suffrage. She was an active member of the Leeds Suffrage Society and a friend of the Suffragist, Millicent Fawcett.**

**The poster, on the opposite page, shows a woman looking at a poster on a door that says, "FACTORY ACTS REGULATIONS FOR WOMEN". The woman is wearing a red shawl, and has her hand on her hip. The caption reads, "THEY HAVE A CHEEK I'VE NEVER BEEN ASKED".**
