- (b) With reference to other aspects of human experience, explore the view that love of one's neighbour is the most important aspect of Jesus' teaching. Justify your answer. [15]
- 4 (a) Give an account of the content and significance of the crucifixion and death of Jesus as recorded in Luke's Gospel. [35]
- (b) With reference to other aspects of human experience, examine the claim that all human suffering is unavoidable. Justify your answer. [15]
