

• Peter and Patrick work on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday

- Sally works on Friday, Saturday and Sunday
- Amy works on Friday, Saturday and Sunday
- Jade and Jo work Sundays only

Mandy would like to use ICT to help manage stock control. She has started a spreadsheet called **Stock Control** to help with this task.

Open the file called **Stock Control** and complete the sheet **Current Stock** as follows:

(k	D)	Embolden the text in cells A1 to M1.	[1]
(0	;)	The sales today for each item are JSTR32L – 3, JSTR34L – 3 and JSTR36L – 8. Enter these figures into the spreadsheet.	[1]
(0	(k	Create a formula in cell E2 which will calculate the unit profit for item JSTR32L. Unit profit is selling price less unit cost.	[2]
(e)	Create a formula in cell J2 which will calculate the takings today for item JSTR32L. Takings today is selling price times sales today.	[2]
(f)	Create a formula in cell K2 which will calculate the closing stock for item JSTR32L. Closing stock is opening stock less sales today.	[2]
(ç	g)	Create a formula in cell L2 which will calculate the total value of closing stock for iter JSTR32L. Closing stock value is closing stock times unit cost.	n [2]
(ł	ו)	In cell M2 create a formula which will display "OK" if the closing stock of item JSTR3 is greater than the minimum stock level for this item, otherwise display "REORDER".	
(i)	Replicate the formulae created in parts (d) to (h) above for the other items.	[2]
(j)	Enter the text "Total Takings Today" in cell A8.	[2]
()	()	In cell B8 create a formula which will calculate the total takings today for ALL items.	[2]
()	Save the file. Print one copy of the spreadsheet data on one A4 page, landscape, with row and column headings and gridlines visible . Make sure that all the data can be seen. Label the printout Current Stock .	[4]

(m) Print one copy of the spreadsheet formulae on one A4 page, landscape, with row and column headings and gridlines visible.
 Make sure that all the formulae can be seen.
 Label the printout Current Stock Formulae.

(b)	The customer whose address is 18 Glenview Park, Belfast, has withdrawn from the mailing list. Delete this customer's details from the database.	[1]
(c)	A mistake was made when entering Jade Brown's details. She is actually a Bronze member. Make this change to the database.	[1]
(d)	Carry out a search to display only the full name and telephone number of all Platinum members. Include field headings.	n [2]
(e)	Save the search as Platinum Members . Print the results of the search on one A4 page. Label the printout Platinum Members .	[1]
(f)	Carry out a search to display all female customers from Belfast. Display only Forename, Surname, Address, Town and Postcode. Include field headings.	[3]
(g)	Save the search as Belfast Females . Print the results of the search on one A4 page. Label the printout Belfast Females .	[1]
