Section A

Answer EITHER Question 1 OR Question 2.

EITHER

- 1 (a) Describe the conversion of Simon when Philip went to a city in Samaria. [5]
 - (b) Examine the account in Acts of Philip's meeting with the Ethiopian official which led to the official's conversion to Christianity. [10]
 - (c) 'Philip's contribution to the development of Christianity was greater than that of Stephen.'

 Discuss this claim. [10]

- 2 (a) Outline the mission of Paul and Silas to Beroea. [5]
 - (b) Explain why Paul and Silas left Thessalonica. [10]
 - (c) 'Paul's missionary journeys would have been more successful if he had not preached the gospel in synagogues.' Discuss this view. [10]

EITHER

- (a) Examine Paul's teaching in 1 Corinthians 11 and 14 about the appearance and behaviour of women at worship.
 - (b) 'Paul's rules about the conduct of worship stifled the spiritual growth of the Corinthian Church.' Evaluate this claim. [15]

- (a) Compare Paul's instructions to slaves and slave-masters in Colossians with the teaching on slavery in 1 Peter.
 - **(b)** Analyse how the New Testament portrays slavery. [15]
