- The data are for the six African countries shown in Table 3.1.

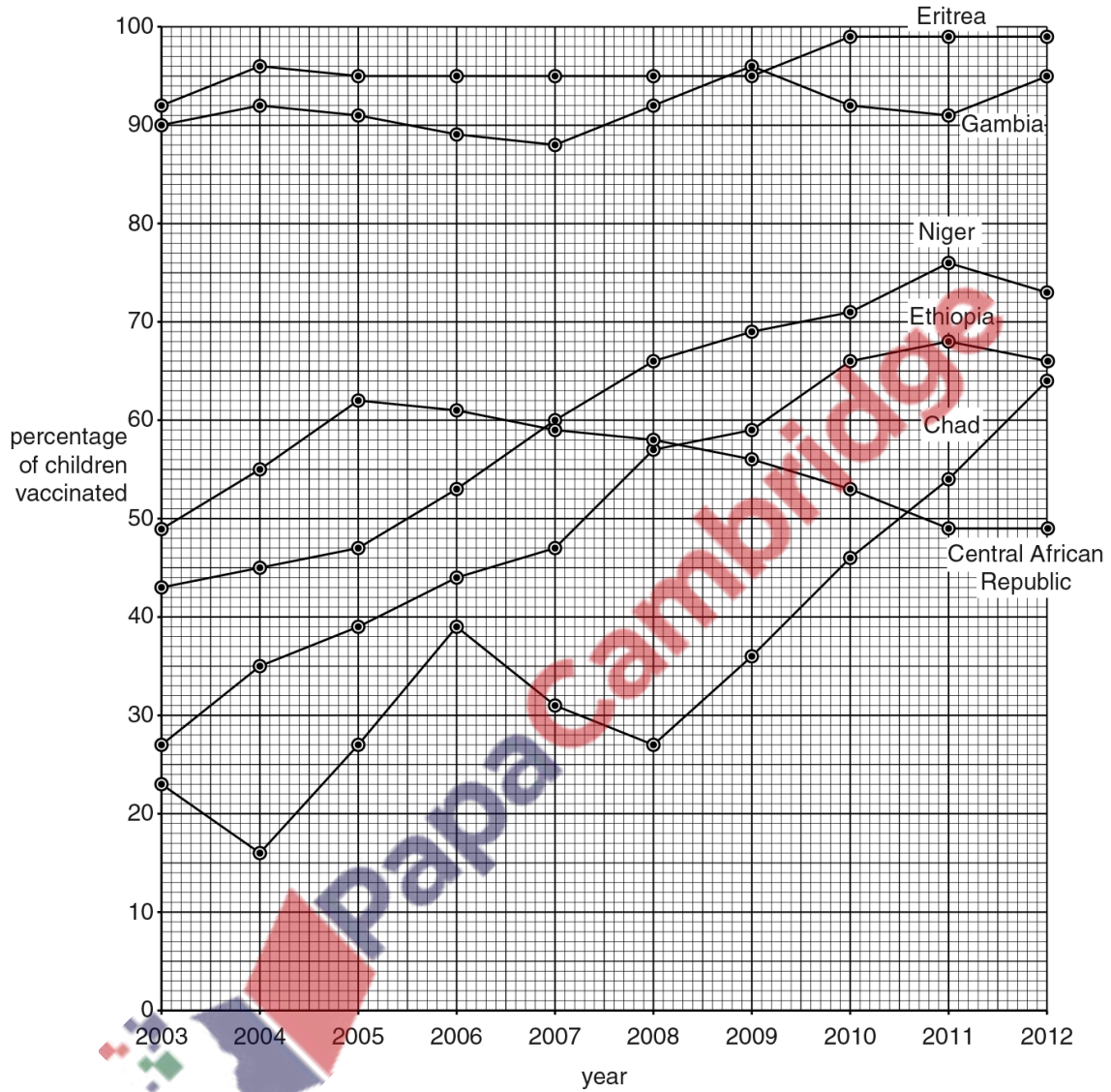

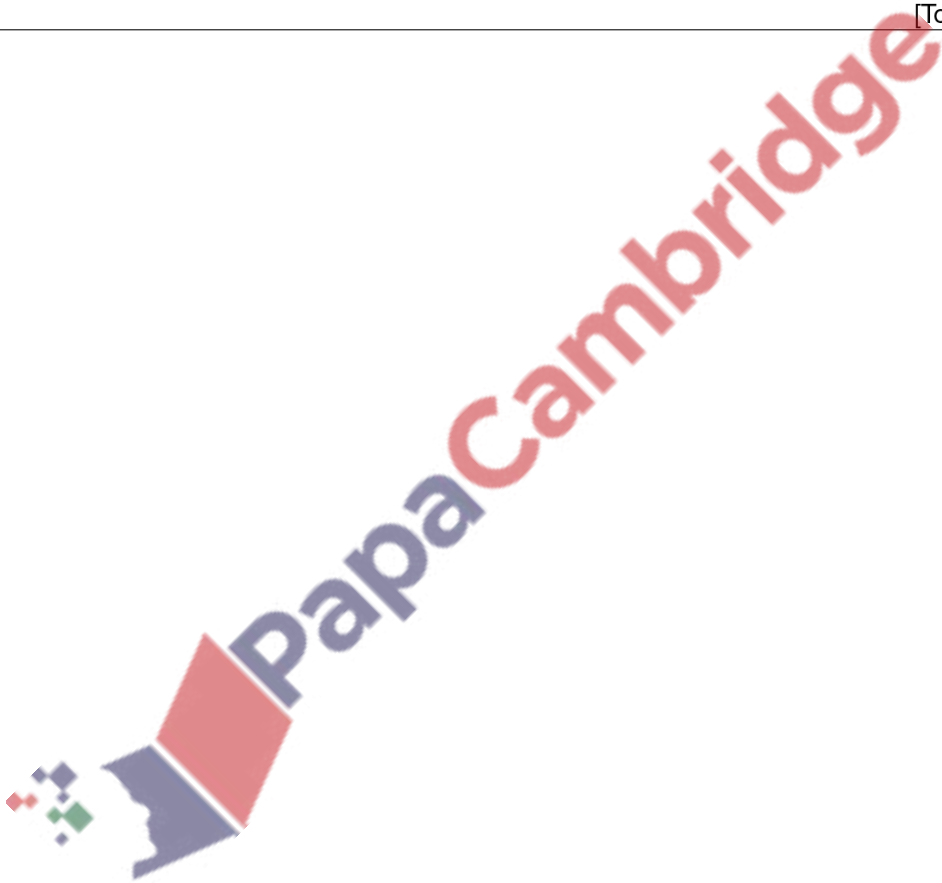
