

Design a costume for a receptionist at a restaurant specializing in dishes from **one** of the following regions:

- (c) Central America

6 **Fabric Design**

7 **Printmaking**

Make a print or a series of prints for a particular month of a Calendar, based on **one** of the following themes:

Images are required for a leaflet for a Charity Appeal, based on **one** of the following themes:

- (a) Care of the aged
- (b) Educational provision
- (c) Urban renewal

You must process and print your own photographs

One main and two supporting photographs should be submitted. All three studies may be mounted on one side of thin card not exceeding A2 in size. Alternatively, they may be contained in a clear plastic cover. Contact prints of negatives, or original digital images, showing other possible angles and views must be included as part of the accompanying preparatory work.
