Grade thresholds taken for Syllabus 0442 (Coordinated Sciences (US)) in the May/June 2013 examination.

The threshold (minimum mark) for BB is set halfway between those for Grades AA and CC. The threshold (minimum mark) for DD is set halfway between those for Grades CC and EE. The threshold (minimum mark) for GG is set as many marks below the FF threshold as the EE threshold is above it. Grade A\*A\* does not exist at the level of an individual component.

The thresholds for the **syllabus** are determined first by adding together the thresholds for the components taken by the candidate. A reduction may be made at the higher grades depending on the correlation of the papers. If the maximum raw marks for the components are not in the weighting/relationship specified in the syllabus, a weighting is applied to arrive at the overall thresholds. The A\*A\* threshold is calculated using the difference between AA and BB as a starting point.

The maximum total mark for this syllabus is **240**.

The overall thresholds for the different grades were set as follows.
