[3:13] Indeed there was a sign for you in the two hosts (which) met together in encounter; one party fighting in the way of Allah and the other unbelieving, whom they saw twice as many as themselves with the sight of the eye and Allah strengthens with His aid whom He pleases; most surely there is a lesson in this for those who have sight.

[3:125] Yea! if you remain patient and are on your guard, and they come upon you in a headlong manner, your Lord will assist you with five thousand of the havoc-making angels.

[8:18] This, and that Allah is the weakener of the struggle of the unbelievers.

Uhad(625 AD)

Remember that morning Thou didst leave Thy household (early) to post the faithful at their stations for battle: And Allah heareth and knoweth all things: (Surah Al-Imran, 121)

Muhammad is no more than an apostle: many Were the apostle that passed away before him. If he died or were slain, will ye then Turn back on your heels? If any did turn back on his heels, not the least harm will he do to Allah. but Allah (on the other hand) will swiftly reward those who (serve Him) with gratitude. (Surah Al-Imran, 144)

Those of you who turned back on the day the two hosts Met,-it was Satan who caused them to fail, because of some (evil) they had done.But Allah Has blotted out (their fault): For Allah is Oft-Forgiving, Most Forbearing. (Surah Al-Imran, 155)

Trench(627 AD)

O ye who believe! Remember the Grace of Allah, (bestowed) on you, when there came down on you hosts (to overwhelm you): But We sent against them a hurricane and forces that ye saw not: but Allah sees (clearly) all that ye do. (Surah Al-Ahzab, 9)

Behold! they came on you from above you and from below you, and behold, the eyes became dim and the hearts gaped up to the throats, and ye imagined various (vain) thoughts about Allah. (Surah Al-Ahzab, 10)

Allah has promised you much booty that you will take [in the future] and has hastened for you this [victory] and withheld the hands of people from you - that it may be a sign for the believers and [that] He may guide you to a straight path.

Conquest of Makkah (630 AD)

And say, "Truth has come, and falsehood has departed. Indeed is falsehood, [by nature], ever bound to depart."(17:81)

He said, "No blame will there be upon you today. Allah will forgive you; and He is the most merciful of the merciful." (12:92)

When the victory of Allah has come and the conquest, And you see the people entering into the religion of Allah in multitudes, (110:1-2)

Hunain(630 AD)

[9:25] Certainly Allah helped you in many battlefields and on the day of Hunain, when your great numbers made you vain, but they availed you nothing and the earth became strait to you notwithstanding its spaciousness, then you turned back retreating.

[9:26] Then Allah sent down His tranquility upon His Messenger and upon the believers, and sent down hosts which you did not see, and chastised those who disbelieved, and that is the reward of the unbelievers.

[9:27] Then will Allah after this turn (mercifully) to whom He pleases, and Allah is Forgiving, Merciful.

Tabuk(630 AD)

Those who remained behind rejoiced in their staying [at home] after [the departure of] the Messenger of Allah and disliked to strive with their wealth and their lives in the cause of Allah and said, 'Do not go forth in the heat." Say, "The fire of Hell is more intensive in heat" - if they would but understand. (9:81)

Final Year

This day I have perfected for you your religion and completed My favor upon you and have approved for you Islam as religion. (5:3)

Hypocrites

(9:67). "The hypocrite men and the hypocrite women are as one another; they enjoin evil and forbid good, and they keep their hands shut. They have forsaken Allah, so He has forsaken them, (too). The hypocrites are indeed the transgressors."

"Praise be to Allah, Who created (out of nothing) the heavens and the earth, Who made the angels messengers with wings - two, or three, or four (pairs) adds to Creation as He pleases: for Allah has power over all things." [35:1]

"Indeed, those who are near your Lord are not prevented by arrogance from His worship, and they exalt Him, and to Him they prostrate" (7:206)

"The angels and the Spirit descend therein by permission of their Lord for every matter" (97:4)"

"He sends down the angels, with the inspiration of His command, upon whom He wills of His servants, [telling them], "Warn that there is no deity except Me; so fear Me." (16:2)

"And indeed, [appointed] over you are keepers," (82:10)

"The Angel of Death, put in charge of you, will (duly) take your souls: then shall ye be brought back to your Lord." (32:11)

"Those who sustain the Throne (of Allah) and those around it sing Glory and Praise to their Lord; believe in Him; and implore forgiveness for those who believe." (Surah Ghafir, 7)

"The Messenger of Allah (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) said: 'When the deceased is buried (or he said: when one of you is buried), there come to him two blue-black angels, one of whom is called Munkar and the other Nakeer.

3)Books

And We certainly sent into every nation a messenger, [saying], "Worship Allah and avoid evil." And among them were those whom Allah guided, and among them were those upon whom error was [deservedly] decreed. So proceed through the earth and observe how the end of the deniers was.(16:36)

"Say, [O believers], "We have believed in Allah and what has been revealed to us and what has been revealed to Abraham and Ishmael and Isaac and Jacob and the Descendants and what was given to Moses and Jesus and what was given to the prophets from their Lord. We make no distinction between any of them, and we are Muslims [in submission] to Him."(2;136)

"We gave David a book [of Psalms]"(17:55)

And when there came to them a Book from Allah VERIFYING THAT WHICH THEY HAVE, and aforetime they used to pray for victory against those who disbelieve, but when there came to them (Prophet) that which they did not recognize, they disbelieved in him; so Allah's curse is on the unbelievers. S. (2:89)

"They distort words from their [proper] usages and have forgotten a portion of that of which they were reminded. And you will still observe deceit among them, except a few of them" (5;13)

"And [mention] when Jesus, the son of Mary, said, "O children of Israel, indeed I am the messenger of Allah to you confirming what came before me of the Torah and bringing good tidings of a messenger to come after me, whose name is Ahmad." But when he came to them with clear evidences, they said, "This is obvious magic." (61:6)

"The scriptures of Abraham and Moses." (87:19)

"Indeed, it is We who sent down the Qur'an and indeed, We will be its guardian." (15;9)

4)Prophets

"Say, [O believers], "We have believed in Allah and what has been revealed to us and what has been revealed to Abraham and Ishmael and Isaac and Jacob and the Descendants and what was given to Moses and Jesus and what was given to the prophets from their Lord. We make no distinction between any of them, and we are Muslims [in submission] to Him."(2;136)

And We did not send any messenger except to be obeyed by permission of Allah(4:64)

We did not send any messenger before you except that We revealed to him that, "There is no deity except Me, so worship Me." (Qur'ān 21:25)

"Muhammad is not the father of [any] one of your men, but [he is] the Messenger of Allah and last of the prophets. And ever is Allah, of all things, Knowing" (33:40)

5) Predestination and Decree

"Indeed, all things We created with predestination". [Quran 54:49]

"Say, "Never will we be struck except by what Allah has decreed for us; He is our protector." And upon Allah let the believers rely." [Quran 9:51]

"No disaster strikes except by permission of Allah. And whoever believes in Allah — He will guide his heart. And Allah is Knowing of all things." [Quran 64:11]

"A matter already enacted" (8:45)

"And when the earth has been extended And has cast out that within it and relinquished [it]" (84:3-4)

6) Day of Judgment

"It is the Day when people will be like moths, dispersed. And the mountains will be like wool, fluffed up" (101:4-5)

Do not these think that they shall be raised again, for a mighty day, the day on which men shall stand before the Lord of the worlds? (83:4-6)

And says man: What! when I am dead shall I truly be brought forth alive? Does not man remember that We created him before, when he was nothing? (19:66-67)

, "On that Day, people will come forward in separate groups to be shown their deeds: whoever has done an atom's weight of good will see it, but whoever has done an atom's weight of evil will see that" (99:6-8).

"Every soul shall have a taste of death" (3:185)

"On the Day a man will flee from his brother. And his mother and his father And his wife and his children", (80:34-36)

"And We will set up a just balance on the day of resurrection"... (21:47)

"On the day when the earth will be changed to other than this earth and the heavens also And they will come forth unto God, The One The Almighty." (Qur'an 14: 48)

And the record [of deeds] will be placed [open], and you will see the criminals fearful of that within it, and they will say, "Oh, woe to us! What is this book that leaves nothing small or great except that it has enumerated it?" And they will find what they did present [before them]. And your Lord does injustice to no one. (18:49)

Then as for one whose scales are heavy [with good deeds], He will be in a pleasant life. But as for one whose scales are light, His refuge will be an abyss.(101:6-9)

Jihad

"The believers are those only who believe in Allah and His Messenger, then they doubt not, and struggle hard with their wealth and their lives in the way of Allah. Such are the truthful ones" (49:15).

"...take not life, which God hath made sacred, except by way of justice and law: thus doth He command you, that ye may learn wisdom." [Al-Qur'an 6:151]

"You are the best nation produced [as an example] for mankind. You enjoin what is right and forbid what is wrong and believe in Allah.(3:110)

And spend of your substance in the cause of Allah, and make not your own hands contribute to (your) destruction; but do good; for Allah loveth those who do good. (Surah Al-Bagara, 195)

And what is [the matter] with you that you fight not in the cause of Allah and [for] the oppressed among men, women, and children who say, "Our Lord, take us out of this city of oppressive people and appoint for us from Yourself a protector and appoint for us from Yourself a helper?" (4:75)

"And if they incline to peace, then incline to it [also] and rely upon Allah . Indeed, it is He who is the Hearing, the Knowing. (8:61)

Except for those who take refuge with a people between yourselves and whom is a treaty or those who come to you, their hearts strained at [the prospect of] fighting you or fighting their own people. And if Allah had willed, He could have given them power over you, and they would have fought you. So if they remove themselves from you and do not fight you and offer you peace, then Allah has not made for you a cause [for fighting] against them." (4:90)

Fighting has been enjoined upon you while it is hateful to you. But perhaps you hate a thing and it is good for you; and perhaps you love a thing and it is bad for you. And Allah Knows, while you know not.(2:216)

"Fight in the way of Allah those who fight you but do not transgress. Indeed. Allah does not like transgressors." (2;190)

And kill them wherever you overtake them and expel them from wherever they have expelled you, and fitnah is worse than killing. And do not fight them at al-Masjid al- Haram until they fight you there. But if they fight you, then kill them. Such is the recompense of the disbelieversAnd if they cease, then indeed, Allah is Forgiving and Merciful. (2:191-192)

"Excepted are those with whom you made a treaty among the polytheists and then they have not been deficient toward you in anything or supported anyone against you; so complete for them their treaty until their term [has ended]. Indeed, Allah loves the righteous [who fear Him" (9:4)

Articles of faith

1) Shahada

I bear witness that none is worthy of worship but ALLAH, the One alone, without partner, and I bear witness that Muhammad is His servant and Messenger.

Indeed, your God is One, Lord of the heavens and the earth and that between them and Lord of the sunrises.

"[He is] Creator of the heavens and the earth. He has made for you from yourselves, mates, and among the cattle, mates; He multiplies you thereby. There is nothing like unto Him, and He is the Hearing, the Seeing." (42:11)

"Muhammad is not the father of any of your men, but he is the Messenger of Allah and the Seal of the Prophets; and Allah has full knowledge of all things." (33:41)

"And whoso obeys Allah and this Messenger of His shall be among those on whom Allah has bestowed His blessings, namely, the Prophets, the Truthful, the Martyrs, and the Righteous. And excellent companions are these." (4:70)

"It is You we worship and You we ask for help" (1:5)

2)Salah

O you who have believed, when you rise to [perform] prayer, wash your faces and your forearms to the elbows and wipe over your heads and wash your feet to the ankles. And if you are in a state of janabah, then purify yourselves. But if you are ill or on a journey or one of you comes from the place of relieving himself or you have contacted women and do not find water, then seek clean earth and wipe over your faces and hands with it. Allah does not intend to make difficulty for you, but He intends to purify you and complete His favor upon you that you may be grateful. (5;6)

"And when you have completed the prayer, remember Allah standing, sitting, or [lying] on your sides. But when you become secure, re-establish [regular] prayer. Indeed, prayer has been decreed upon the believers a decree of specified times." (4:103)

And from wherever you go out [for prayer], turn your face toward al-Masjid al-Haram.(2:150)

And establish prayer and give zakah and bow with those who bow [in worship and obedience].(2:43)

"The first act the slave will be held accountable for will be his prayer"

"Indeed, prayer prohibits immorality and wrongdoing, and the remembrance of Allah is greater. And Allah knows that which you do." (29:45)

Certainly will the believers have succeeded: They who are during their prayer humbly submissive (23;1-2)

So be patient over what they say and exalt [Allah] with praise of your Lord before the rising of the sun and before its setting; and during periods of the night [exalt Him] and at the ends of the day, that you may be satisfied. (2:130)

"Prayer in congregation is 27 times better than alone"

"If there are three persons in a village and they do not pray together, the devil would take over them. So pray together, as a wolf only harms a solitary sheep"

"And bow down your heads with those who bow down: (2:43)

3) Fasting

O you who have believed, decreed upon you is fasting as it was decreed upon those before you that you may become righteous –(2:183)

"When the month of Ramadan comes, the doors of Heaven are opened and the doors of Hell are closed and the Satan is locked in chains"

"I intend to keep tomorrows fast of ramadan"

"O Allah! I fasted for You and I believe in You [and I put my trust in You] and I break my fast with Your sustenance."

"The thirst has gone and the veins are quenched, and reward is confirmed, if Allah wills."

"Indeed, We sent the Qur'an down during the Night of Decree." (97:1)

"Whoever does not give up forged speech and evil actions, Allah is in no need of his fasting"

"Fasting is a shield from the Hellfire just like a shield of yours in battle."

"Fasting has two joys. One when he breaks the fast and the other when he meets his Lord"

We sent it (this Qur'an) down on a blessed Night. Verily, We are ever warning (mankind of Our Torment). Therein (that Night) is decreed every matter of ordainment. Amran (i.e. a command or this Qur'an or His Decree of every matter) from Us. Verily, We are ever sending (the Messenger). (As) a Mercy from your Lord. Verily! He is the All-Hearer, the All-Knower." (Ad-Dukhaan 44: 3-6)

:"... whoever fasts during Ramadan out of sincere faith and hoping to attain Allah's rewards, then all his past sins will be forgiven."

"There is a gate to Paradise that is called ar-Rayyan. On the Day of Resurrection it will say: 'Where are those who fasted?' When the last [one] has passed through the gate, it will be locked." [Imam Bukhari and Imam Muslim].

"The unpleasant smell coming out from the mouth of a fasting person is better in the sight of Allah than the smell of musk"

4)ZAKAT

Zakah expenditures are only for the poor and for the needy and for those employed to collect [zakah] and for bringing hearts together [for Islam] and for freeing captives [or slaves] and for those in debt and for the cause of Allah and for the [stranded] traveler - an obligation [imposed] by Allah. And Allah is Knowing and Wise. (9:60)

"There is no charity due on less than five camels, and there is no charity due on what is less than five Uqiyah (of silver), and there is no charity due on what is less than five Wasaq."

"Allah has enjoined Zakat so the rest of your wealth is cleansed through"

Take, [0, Muhammad], from their wealth a charity by which you purify them and cause them increase, and invoke [Allah's blessings] upon them. Indeed, your invocations are reassurance for them. And Allah is Hearing and Knowing. (9:103)

And whatever you give for interest to increase within the wealth of people will not increase with Allah. But what you give in zakah, desiring the countenance of Allah - those are the multipliers. (30:39)

"The Messenger of Allah said: 'I have exempted you from (having to pay Zakah on) houses and slaves, and there is no Zakah on less than two hundred (Dirhams)."

<u>5)Hajj</u>

And [due] to Allah from the people is a pilgrimage to the House – for whoever is able to find thereto a way. But whoever disbelieves – then indeed, Allah is free from need of the worlds. (3:97)

Indeed, as-Safa and al-Marwah are among the symbols of Allah. So whoever makes Hajj to the House or performs 'umrah - there is no blame upon him for walking between them. And whoever volunteers good - then indeed, Allah is appreciative and Knowing.(2;158)

And the camels and cattle We have appointed for you as among the symbols of Allah; for you therein is good. So mention the name of Allah upon them when lined up [for sacrifice]; and when they are [lifeless] on their sides, then eat from them and feed the needy and the beggar. Thus have We subjected them to you that you may be grateful. (22;36)

"Whoever performs Haj for the sake of Pleasing Allah, and does not utter any disgusting remarks of sexual nature, nor commits any evil, will return as free from sins as the day in which his mother gave birth to him". [Bukhari, Muslim]

"I am at Your service, O Allah, I am at Your service. You have no partner. I am at Your service. Praise and blessing belong to You, and the Kingdom. You have no partner."

And when he reached with him [the age of] exertion, he said, "O my son, indeed I have seen in a dream that I [must] sacrifice you, so see what you think." He said, "O my father, do as you are commanded. You will find me, if Allah wills, of the steadfast." (37:102)

And [mention] when We made the House a place of return for the people and [a place of] security. And take, [O believers], from the standing place of Abraham a place of prayer. And We charged Abraham and Ishmael, [saying], "Purify My House for those who perform Tawaf and those who are staying [there] for worship and those who bow and prostrate [in prayer]."(2:125)

There is no blame upon you for seeking bounty from your Lord [during Hajj]. But when you depart from 'Arafat, remember Allah at al- Mash'ar al-Haram. And remember Him, as He has guided you, for indeed, you were before that among those astray. (2;198)

Islamiyat

- 1) Firstly, increase your writing speed. It might sound tough but its beneficial. The exam of islamiyat is 1 hr, 30 min and you have to write as quickly as possible. Therefore to increase your writing speed, you should practice questions in the time limit. Time division is essential. 10-13min for Q1,almost 22-25 minutes for the rest 4 questions. This II leave you 5 to 7 minutes for rechecking. Practice especially 10 markers in 16 to 18 minutes via stopwatch
- 2) Read from as many sources as you can (if you have much time) or if you don't, read from Yasim Malik and/or Mustafa Draper. You can also read from the best isl notes of Muzzamil Mehmood http://www.mediafire.com/.../Islamiyat_notes_by_Sir_Muzzamil...
- 3) Learn as much quotations as possible. Examiners give a higher grade to those answers which have more references. The best of learning references is by writing and repeatedly reading
- 4)For Q1 of both papers, ratta is unnecessarily except the quotation. You get the answer from the passage on both a and b parts. Also dont use "should" in b part as it gives bad impression on the examiner. Use alternative words like "Ought to,must, required to" The answer is created from the passage e.g in Surah Ikhlas " He begets not, nor is born". Meaning no physical relations with anyone and no son and father.
- Tho u should memorize the passages as often the questions comes in Q2(what do thr quranic passages tell us about relationship with god)
- 5)For 10 marker, you need to write as much as you remember about that event/article/pillar etc. Reference must be provided and you must give the required detail. Muzzamil notes have all the necessary details (write in own words)
- 6) For 4 marker, your evaluation skills are discussed so no ratta. You may or may not provide references. You have evaluate why something is imp to Muslims etc. The answer is deduced from your mind. e.g could Quran be the only source of guidance if there was no hadith. You can say that if hadith was not there, the Quran would be misunderstood as many verses required commentary. IThe haidhh also provided laws which the quran did not fully speak about e.g Zakat. Etc
- 7)Do all the syllbus and dont depend upon guess papers. You can never rely upon them as if you do and no question comes, boy you are screwed.
- 8)Once you have done the syllabus, go through past papers

- 8)Read every question very carefully, CAIEs can trick students. Read the questions vert carefully for the 1st minute and decide which ones to do
- 9)Lastly believe in yourself Also Dua. Islamiyat is easy but it still requires hardwork and practice. So give it your all and IA youll achieve and A*
- 10)Learning from extra sources such as islamic videos(merciful servant) as well as six authentic books gives u an edge for references and information
