The extent of lava flows from the Mauna Loa volcano, Hawaii, USA, since 1843



Hazard map for Mauna Loa volcano, Hawaii



Average number of tornado reports, per 100 square miles, in part of the USA, 1957–2006



River regimes for two mountain rivers in Washington State, USA, 2002



Some of the main global flows of cocaine, and cocaine consumption, for 2008



Factors where affluence might affect health



