



E-buyers in EU member states, 2015 as a percentage of total population aged 16 to 74




EU member states, 2015



Types of rural areas in Scotland











Projected percentage population change, 2006 to 2031 in Scotland


major urban areas




1:50 000 OS map of part of North Yorkshire, England










The relationship between river velocity and grain size






Roundness index with distance from the source of a river for selected bedload materials
