



Mean annual rainfall for selected weather stations in and around London, UK



Mean annual temperature for selected weather stations in and around London, UK




forested area 06:00


- - - forested area 15:00

Income deprivation in North Somerset, England, 2015



Crime deprivation in North Somerset, England, 2015



Number of households by income group for rural and urban settlements in India, 2005



Predicted number of households by income group for rural and urban settlements in India, 2025



The condition of coral reefs in Mexico, Belize and Honduras, 2008 to 2012



Percentage change in the Reef Health Index (RHI) for selected coral reefs in Mexico, Belize and Honduras, 2006 to 2012



